## Ministry Responsibility Description Aurora Interchurch Task Force, Inc. (AITF) Outreach Umbrella



**Brief description of the ministry**: Collects food and non-perishable items brought to the church by parishioners the first weekend of each month. These goods are taken to the food and clothing bank run by AITF.

**Qualifications**: To give groceries there are no qualifications. To be a driver/liaison one must be able to load and unload grocery bags and boxes weighing 30 pounds. Be 18 or older and have a valid driver's license and a vehicle capable of holding 50 bags or boxes of groceries.

**Training**: Accompany the drivers from St. Michael's and meet the food chair at AITF any first Sunday.

**Time Commitment**: Drive groceries once a quarter from church to AITF at 1553 Clinton Street, Aurora 80010-2004.

**Miscellaneous**: St. Michael the Archangel Church has been a Board member of AITF for more than twenty years and has provided groceries once a month for more than a decade. It is estimated that St. Michael's has provided more than \$100K worth of in-kind to AITF in the past ten years.
