Frequently

What are the requirements to have a Baptism at St. Michael's?

- Child must be under 7 years old
- The Godparent must be a fully-initiated Catholic
- You must obtain and submit St. Michael's baptism registration packet
- Parents and Godparents must attend a Baptism preparation class before the Baptism Celebration

What are the steps?

- Obtain a Baptism registration packet
- Register for Baptism preparation class
- Attend Baptism preparation class
- Submit completed Baptism registration packet forms to the class
- Schedule Baptism celebration
- Schedule presentation, if the Baptism celebration is on a Saturday at 9:00am
- Call the parish office one week before the Baptism celebration to confirm that all the paperwork has been received and that all of the steps have been completed
- Is there a fee?
- No, but if you would like to make a donation, please give it to the celebrant on the day of the Baptism

Asked

Where may I obtain a Baptism registration packet?

- You may pick up the packet at the parish office during office hours
- You may download it from our website; it is located under the "Sacraments" tab

Where and when do I submit the Baptism registration packet?

- You must take the completed packet with a copy of the birth certificate to the Baptism preparation class
- If you have already taken the class within the last two years, and have proof of attendance, you can submit the completed packet with a copy of the birth certificate to the Parish office and will not be required, though it is encouraged to attend the class

How do I register for a class?

- The contact number is located in the Baptism registration packet
- You must first obtain the Baptism packet in order to register

May we take the Baptism preparation class here and have the Baptism celebration elsewhere?

- Yes, just be sure to pick up the Baptism preparation class information forms from the parish office in order to register
- You will need to request a class attendance letter when you register

Questions

May I bring my child to the class?

- No, we do not offer child-care. The information in the class is important; we would like your full, active participation

May I have my child baptized if I was not married through the church?

- Yes, we welcome all parents seeking Baptism for their children

What are the requirements to be a Godparent?

- Must be a fully-initiated Catholic, meaning they have received the Sacraments of Baptism, First Communion, and Confirmation
- Must be 16 years or older
- Must participate regularly at Sunday Masses and receive Holy Communion
- If married, must be married according to the teachings and laws of the Catholic Church
- Those cohabitating do not meet the requirements
- We are willing to work with you if you have any questions or concerns about these requirements
