Parish Pastoral Council

Administration Umbrella

The Finance Council approved the budget for Fiscal Year 2024-2025. The parish is currently on, or slightly above, budget for FY 2023-2024. Administration staff has begun work on year end financial reports.

A portion of the main offertory collection at the Mother's Day weekend Masses were contributed to the annual Pro-Life Mother's Day collection. Monies will be used for the operating expenses of the Archdiocesan Respect Life Office. The office produces educational programs used throughout the Archdiocese, including in Catholic Schools, as well as other projects such as 40 Days for Life, Prayer in the Square, and Respect Life Radio podcasts.

On the following weekend, a portion of the offertory was contributed to the Catholic Communication Campaign, which will be used to support communication projects in the Denver Archdiocese, and nation and worldwide projects.

The generosity of parishioners, which enables the parish to support these worthy projects, is greatly appreciated.
